

## The Highland International Rally 29<sup>th</sup> May - 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2025

The VMCC North West Section is planning an "International" rally. Based in the Welsh Highlands, in the charming town of Caernarfon North West Wales, we have already booked accommodation at the Celtic Royal Hotel in the town centre as part of the rally. However, if you wish to make your own arrangements and join us for the rally only, there are alternative accommodation and camping sites near by.

Here's what's included:



<u>Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> May 2025</u> For those able to join us today we will be departing from the hotel at noon for a half day ride across near by Anglesey. The largest island in the UK this island faces Caernarfon across the Meni Straight. We will visit Treardurr Bay and South Stack (weather permitting)

**Friday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2025** Todays ride takes us through the Snowdonia National Park riding through Bethesda, Bewtsy Coed. We will stop for refreshments at the summit of the Great Orm overlooking the pleasant town of Llandudno. Later we ride through Conway, passing the imposing castle and along the Conway Vally. We will return to the hotel along the Llanberis pass



**Saturday 31**st **May 2025** A big day today we ride south through Porthmadog and Dolgellau. Our lunch stop will be at Devil's Bridge near Aberystwyth in the foot hills of the Cambrian Mountains. The return takes us back via some scenic roads along Cardigan Bay passing through Barmouth

<u>Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2025</u> Today we ride West across the Lleyn Penninsular. We ride out as far as Bardsey Sound with views of Bardsey Island. Later we ride via Criccieth and make a stop at the charming village of Port Merion, the brain Child of Sir Clough

Williams Ellis huilt in the 1000s - then enter the elete mining region around Disensus



Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> June Our last day and return home after breakfast

Rally Routes: Entrants will be provided with route sheets (Tulip) for each dayas well as electronic routes which can be downloaded prior to the rally. A backup vehicle will follow on for breakdown assistance (used at your own risk). The journeys are not timed so extended stays at places of interest are possible, but this may result in you losing the support of the backup vehicle, so individual breakdown cover is recommended.

## Rally fees: £150 per bike & rider an additional £150 per pillion

 $3 \frac{1}{2}$  days riding including a tea and lunch stop each day.

<u>Rally Accommodation 4 nights £350</u> per person dinner bed and breakfast, sharing a room. £140 single room supplement.

Location; The Celtic Roay Hotel Caernarfon

The rally begins on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> May 2025, check in from 2pm on Sunday 21st. The accommodation consists of 4 nights (Thursday - Monfday) dinner bed and breakfast. There is ample off-road parking for vans and trailers. Other accommodation can be found in the Town, as well as nearby camping (tents/ caravans /motorhomes)

<u>The rally is for solo motorcycles and sidecar combinations manufactured up to 1980</u>, special awards will be given to pre-war machines.
